



Impact on our operations by the Pacific Coast of Eastern Japan Earthquake

KYOKUTO expresses its deepest condolences for all those that lost their lives as a result of the Pacific Coast of Eastern Japan Earthquake. At the same time, KYOKUTO wishes for the earliest recovery of the region and the safety of the residents. KYOKUTO reports on the most recent conditions of its employees and facilities affected by the huge earthquake as follows.

Immediately after the huge earthquake, KYOKUTO established its Emergency Task Force at our headquarters in Tokyo, for the recovery and confirmation of the latest status.

1. Regarding KYOKUTO's Employees

KYOKUTO has confirmed that all employees are safe.

2. Production Facility

The damage of KYOKUTO's Takahagi plant was minimal. As a result of recovery efforts, its plant production could be resumed on March 22nd (Tuesday).

3. Delivery Facility

No damage has been reported at the Logistic Center in Takahagi plant. Though logistic operations were resumed on March 15th, the delivery could delay due to the disaster. If the logistic network is improved, the problem of this delay would be solved soon.

4. Sales Facility

No damage has been reported at Sendai branch in Sendai city.
